INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed proposals for **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day** will be received by the Purchasing Agent, Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH), General Service Annex, 401 14th Street South, Birmingham, AL 35233, until 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 18, 2022, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders wishing to bid can download the complete solicitation including the specifications and bid forms via the internet at www.jcdh.org (go to the **ABOUT** header and click on **BIDS**), or by visiting the Purchasing Office at the address shown above, or by calling (205) 930-1961, fax (205) 930-1060 and requesting a copy be mailed to you. Any addenda will be available on the internet. Bidder is responsible for checking for addenda until bid opening date. Addenda will be mailed only to those vendors who were provided a copy in person or by mail.

All proposals must be submitted on Bid Form in a sealed envelope indicating “**SEALED BID – ITB #20-04-10, “Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day”**” with opening date and bid number printed on outside of the envelope.

All bidders **must** complete and return the notarized State of Alabama disclosure form included in the bid package and the Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract, and **must** provide a copy of their E-verify certificate with the assigned number from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and all other documents listed in the enclosure.

It is required for any contract/purchase exceeding \$10,000.00 that the bidder submits with their bid either a certified check, a cashier’s check, or a bid bond payable to the JCDH in the amount of \$500.00. In order for any bid award to be considered that exceeds \$10,000, it must be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond or check. Bid bonds will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of the award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond or check shall be forfeited.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening. Jefferson County Department of Health is exempt from all taxes. This statement in no way is to be construed as relieving a seller or contractor from paying any tax assessed to him as a seller or contractor.

Jefferson County Department of Health expressly reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or parts of proposals and to make the award all or none or per line item on the merit and/or feature of method and quality, delivery, and service availability as the best interest of the JCDH appears.

Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to require documentation that each bidder is an

established business and is abiding by the ordinances, regulations, and laws of their community and the State of Alabama. If you are required by any regulatory agency to maintain a professional license or certification to provide any product and/or service solicited under this (ITB), the JCDH reserves the right to require documentation of current license and/or certification before considering and awarding the bid.

COMMUNICATION DURING BID EVALUATION

There shall be no communication during the evaluation period between any vendor and the Jefferson County Department of Health agency requisitioning the goods or services to be procured. Any communications, written, oral, or electronic between the vendor and requisitioning agency must come through the Division of Purchasing Buyer administering the ITB.

INVITATION TO BID

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

The Jefferson County Department of Health is seeking qualified firms to provide a 3-year professional service for an Annual HHW Day event in the month of April. Proposals are requested to provide the identification, packing, pick-up, transportation, and disposal of household hazardous waste items. The proposer shall dispose of such waste materials in accordance with the hazardous waste requirements outlined in the administrative code for the state of Alabama. While the HHW items listed in the requirement section do not include the number of roll-offs needed or services that may be required such as chemist and field technicians, the bidder's proposal should recommend such services. The successful bidder will be notified of the ITB award via JCDH's Notice of Award letter and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract.

BACKGROUND

The JCDH, located in Birmingham, Alabama, serves a population of about 660,000 residents. Jefferson County Department of Health serves the most populous county in the state by providing primary and limited specialty care and core public health services to county residents. The mission of JCDH is to prevent disease, assure access to quality health care, promote a healthy lifestyle and environment, and protect against public health threats.

The Jefferson County Department of Health and Storm Water Management Authority, Inc. are hosting a one-day Annual HHW Disposal event with three different site locations operating simultaneously. The event is for the Jefferson County communities, located in the Westside, Eastside, and Northside areas of Jefferson County, Alabama. This event will provide the community an outlet to properly dispose of common household hazardous materials that require appropriate disposal by trained and licensed disposal personnel.

QUALIFICATIONS/CONSULTANT SELECTION CRITERIA

All proposals submitted will be evaluated on the following:

- Understanding of and ability to meet the goals and objectives of this ITB
- Requirements and qualifications
- Description of the project team, including roles and responsibilities
- References of clients with similar scope of work
- Cover letter is required (Statement of Project Understanding)

VENDOR CONTACTS

The successful firm will be the only contact about this professional services referenced. Proposals will not be accepted by vendors that sub-contract their work.

TERMS

The bid will be valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of award and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract.

AWARD

Award will be made in whole to the lowest and best service capabilities responsible bidder provided the vendor meets all requirements and specifications required by the JCDH.

PRICE

Price will remain firm for the entire duration of the bid period. The price is to include **all** related fees. Invoice(s) must be itemized and billed after completion.

FREIGHT

Price includes transportation, fuel, handling, service, freight charges, and deliveries as specified and JCDH will pay no additional fees.

TAX

JCDH is exempt from all taxes. However, the bidder shall be responsible for any tax that may be levied or assessed by reason of this transaction.

BUDGET SUMMARY

A budget has not been established for this expense, a non-binding budget summary should be attached to list the cost estimate of each component to facilitate funding requests within JCDH and in compliance with the Compensation Amount and Schedule Section.

PRE-PAY

No pre-payments will be made prior to shipment.

INTERPRETATIONS

No modification, deviation, substitution, or other such changes will be made without the Owner's prior written approval. The Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to reject any or all proposals submitted and to make the award in the best interest of the Health Department.

TERMINATION

The bid may be terminated by the Jefferson County Department of Health with a thirty (30) day written notice of cancelation to the other party regardless of the reason. Any violation of this agreement shall constitute a breach and default of this agreement. Such termination shall not relieve the contractor of any liability to JCDH for damages sustained by virtue of a breach by the contractor.

INSURANCE

Bidder shall furnish to the Board upon execution of this Agreement, a certificate of insurance as evidence of adequate professional and public liability insurance insuring vendor, the Board, and Board's agents, servants and employees as additional insured.

ADDITIONS TO CONTRACT

The JCDH has attempted to list all components related to ITB for **"Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day"** that will be required during the term of the contract. However, JCDH reserves the right to purchase additional services as needed from the successful bidder as it relates to this scope of work for this said project.

ITB proposals will be rejected if there is reason to believe that collusion exists among the bidders. No participants in such collusion will be considered in future proposals for the same work.

Bidder must have all necessary business licenses as required by the State of Alabama and Jefferson County. All items must conform strictly to the specifications and shall be subjected to evaluation upon acceptance. In the event that any item is deemed unacceptable or not in conformity with the specifications, items will be rejected and items of proper quality as set forth in these specifications shall be furnished in place thereof at the expense of the successful bidder.

INCURRING COSTS

The Jefferson County Department of Health will not be liable for any costs incurred in preparing bid responses.

Failure to deliver as specified and in accordance with the ITB submitted, including promised delivery, will constitute sufficient grounds for cancelation of the order and contract at the option of JCDH.

Use of specific names and numbers is not intended to restrict the bidding of any seller and/or manufacturer, but is solely for the purpose of indicating the type, size and quality, material, service, or equipment considered best adapted to the JCDH's intended use.

No bidder shall be allowed to offer more than one proposal for the said project. If said bidder should submit more than one proposal for the said project described therein those proposals shall be rejected.

GUARANTEE

Bidder certifies by bidding that he is fully aware of the conditions of service and purpose for which item(s) included in this ITB are to be purchased and that their offering will meet these requirements of service and purpose to the satisfaction of the JCDH and its Agent.

REQUIREMENTS

- Provide evidence of authorization from the Interstate Commerce Commission and
the appropriate State Agency to operate as a common carrier.
- Provide evidence of a valid, satisfactory Federal (USDOT) Motor Carrier Safety Rating.
- Provide evidence of a valid Federal (USDOT) Hazardous Materials Certificate of
Registration.
