Sealed bids for ITB #24-02-03 Air Monitoring Instruments Services, will be received by the Purchasing Agent, Jefferson County Department of Health, General Service Annex, 401 14th Street South, Birmingham, AL 35233 General Service Annex, 401 14th Street South, Birmingham, AL 35233, until 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, March 13, 2024, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders wishing to bid can download the complete solicitation including the specifications and bid forms via the internet at www.jcdh.org (go to the ABOUT header and click on BIDS), or by visiting the Purchasing Office at the address shown above, or by calling (205) 930-1961, fax (205) 930-1060 and requesting a copy be mailed to you. Any addenda will be available on the internet. Bidder is responsible for checking for addenda until bid opening date. Addenda will be mailed only to those vendors who were provided a copy in person or by mail.

All bids must be submitted on Bid Form in a sealed envelope indicating "SEALED BID – BID #24-02-03 ITB #24-02-03 Air Monitoring Instruments Services" with opening date and bid number printed on outside of envelope.

All bidders **must** complete and return the notarized State of Alabama disclosure form included in the bid package <u>and</u> the Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract; and **must** provide their E-verify number and a copy of their E-verify certificate and all other documents listed in the enclosure.

It is <u>required</u> for any contract/purchase exceeding \$10,000.00 that the bidder submits with their bid either certified check, a cashier's check or a bid bond payable to the Jefferson County Department of Health in the amount of \$500.00. In order for any bid award to be considered that exceeds \$10,000, it must be accompanied by an acceptable bid bond or check. Bid bonds will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders after the formal award is made and to the successful bidder after acceptance of the award. Should the successful bidder fail to accept the award, the bid bond or check shall be forfeited.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening. Jefferson County Department of Health is exempt from all tax. This statement in no way is to be construed as relieving a seller or contractor from paying any tax assessed to him as a seller or contractor.

Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH) expressly reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or parts of bids and to make the award all or none or per line item on the merit and/or feature of method and quality, delivery, and service availability as the best interest of the Jefferson County Department of Health appears.

Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to require documentation that each bidder is an established business and is abiding by the ordinances, regulations, and laws of their community and the State of Alabama. If you are required by any regulatory agency to maintain professional license or certification to provide any product and/or service solicited under this Invitation To Bid (ITB), the JCDH reserves the right to require documentation of current license and/or certification before considering and awarding the bid.

Telephone inquiries with questions regarding clarification of all specifications of the ITB <u>will not</u> be accepted. By submitting, Bidder agrees that it has examined the sites, specifications and accepts without recourse, all site conditions.

GENERAL

The Jefferson County Department of Health (JCDH) is to establish a professional services contract with firm pricing for ITB #24-02-03 Air Monitoring Instruments Services. Services to include air monitoring instruments preventative maintenance and assessments, analyzers installation and technician training. Successful bidder will be notified of bid award via Jefferson County Department of Health's Notice of Award letter and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract.

GUARANTEE

Bidder certifies by bidding that he is fully aware of the conditions of service and purpose for which item(s) included in this bid are to be purchased, and that their offering will meet these requirements of service and purpose to the satisfaction of the Jefferson County Department of Health and its Agent.

INCURRING COSTS

The Jefferson County Department of Health will not be liable for any costs incurred in preparing bid responses.

TERMS

The bid will be valid for a period of a **three (3) year term**. Successful bidder will be notified of ITB award via JCDH's Notice of Award letter and the approved Standard Addendum to Bid Agreement Contract.

TERMINATION

The bid may be terminated by JCDH with a thirty (30) day written notice of cancelation to the other party regardless of reason. Any violation of this agreement shall constitute a breach and default of this agreement. Such termination shall not relieve the contractor of any liability to JCDH for damages sustained by virtue of a breach by the contractor.

PRICE

Price will remain firm for the entire duration of the bid period. Price is to include <u>all</u> related fees. <u>Invoice(s) must be itemized.</u>

FREIGHT

Price includes transportation, fuel, handling, service, freight charges and deliveries/pick-up as specified and JCDH will pay no additional fees.

PRE-PAY

No pre-payments will be made prior to shipment.

COMMUNICATION DURING BID EVALUATION

There shall be no communication during the evaluation period between any vendor and JCDH agency requisitioning the good or service to be procured. Any communications, written, oral, or electronic between the vendor and the requisition agency must come through the Division of Purchasing Buyer administering the ITB.

AWARD

Award will be made in whole to the <u>lowest responsible bidder</u> provided the vendor meet all requirements and specifications required by the JCDH.

ADDITIONS TO CONTRACT

The County has attempted to list the locations for "ITB #24-02-03 Air Monitoring Instruments Services" that will be required during the term of the contract. However, JCDH reserves the right to purchase additional services and/or delete locations as needed from the successful bidder.

INSURANCE

Bidder shall furnish to the Board upon execution of this Agreement, a certificate of insurance as evidence of adequate professional and public liability insurance insuring vendor, the Board and Board's agents, servants and employees as additional insured.

Bid proposals will be rejected if there is reason to believe that collusion exists among the bidders. No participants in such collusion will be considered in future proposals for the same work.

Bidder must have all necessary business licenses as required by the State of Alabama and Jefferson County. All items must conform strictly to the specifications and shall be subjected to evaluation upon acceptance. In the event that any item is deemed unacceptable or not in conformity with the specifications, items will be rejected, and items of proper quality as set forth in these specifications shall be furnished in place thereof at the expense of the successful bidder.

SCOPE OF WORK

CATEGORY I. PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OPERATIONAL SERVICES:

Preventative maintenance services will be performed as follows:

- a) One time task initial audit of sites and the equipment assessment
- b) Conduct site audits per EPA regulation 2x/year
- c) Conduct and validate Ozone Photometer Standards 2x/year,
 May require additional services if an issue occurs on site that requires further troubleshooting
- d) Conduct Quality Assurance instrument audits per EPA regulation At least 2x/year on ALL equipment, prefer gases quarterly (4x/year)
- e) Conduct Mass Flow Controller Certifications 2x/year
- f) Operate/Calibrate/Maintain/Repair equipment per EPA regulation
- g) Gases have a 3-month calibration every 3 months (includes line loss and SLIC tests)
- h) Annual maintenance on equipment

HOURS OF SERVICE:

i) Normal business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday except for the Jefferson County Department of Health's official holidays.

REPORTING OF SERVICE PERFORMED

j) Service men are to report to customer upon arrival. A written report shall be submitted after each inspection with recommendations of change to the equipment. After each service, service ticket indicating the service to the unit that work was performed must be completed. The ticket should be emailed to Environmental Health Department Personnel for review. The maintenance and repair invoices submitted within 30 days of service.

CATEGORY II. DATA REVIEW:

- a) Review of Data from air vision
- b) Compose data package from each site regarding data trends, missing data, annotations, logbooks etc. for entry into AQS
- c) Remote Data Review and Data Validation

CATEGORY III. INSTALLATION SERVICES (ONE-TIME):

Installation services will be performed as follows:

a) T640 installation: 3 each b) 2025i installation: 6 each

c) Fairfield- Wylam site consolidation:

Move equipment from Fairfield site to Wylam site. Install new T640 and move CO, SO2 and Ozone from Fairfield to Wyam site. Price is to include **all** related fees.

SCOPE OF WORK

CATEGORY IV. TRAINING TECHNICIANS:

- a) Training the Air and Radiation Protection Division's technicians in the field of the instruments listed under the specification section. The courses may focus on the following: Theory of operation, menu structure, maintenance and calibrations, pneumatic and electronic troubleshooting with hands-on labs, common failures, and APICOM/DAS/Ethernet, and other courses based on per EPA regulation and JCDH Air Pollution's specific topics of interest. The specific training courses will be initiated upon request by the Environmental Health Department Personnel.
- b) Make any recommendation, in writing to the Air and Radiation Protection Division Personnel that would make the systems more efficient or improve the equipment's performance.
- c. On-site (In-person) Training on the equipment listed. The price is to include **all** related fees.
