

Dental Bid

Question 1

Would electronic signatures (e.g., DocuSign) be accepted in place of original signatures and notarization requirements?

Answer:

No. Electronic signatures are **not accepted**. All documents requiring signatures must contain **original (wet) signatures** and be submitted in the sealed bid package as required by the ITB.

Question 2

Can notarized documents be submitted electronically, or must they be physically included in the sealed bid package?

Answer:

Notarized documents must be **physically included** in the sealed bid package. Electronic or emailed notarized documents will **not** be accepted.

Question 3

For the bid submission deadline of June 11, 2026, is the requirement based on the postmark date, or must the bid be received by that date and time?

Answer:

Bids must be **received** by the Jefferson County Department of Health **no later than 10:00 a.m. CST on June 11, 2026**. The postmark date does **NOT** determine timely submission. Bids received after the deadline will not be opened or considered.

Question 4

Is the Addendum to the Bid Agreement Contract required to be submitted with the bid, or completed only upon award?

Answer:

The **Addendum to the Bid Agreement Contract is required to be completed and submitted with the bid**. Failure to submit the completed Addendum may result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.

Question 5

We are interested in submitting a bid; however, we do not sell all of the items requested. Are we able to submit a partial bid for just the items we sell? We understand we can offer a substitute if the item is not marked “NO SUB.”

Answer:

Yes. Vendors may submit a **partial bid** for the items they are able to supply.

The Jefferson County Department of Health reserves the right to make award **“all or none” or per line item**, as stated in the ITB. Vendors may offer substitutions **only for items not marked “NO SUB,”** provided the substitute meets all specifications outlined in the solicitation.

Bidders must comply with all ITB requirements, including the limitation of **one price per line item** and adherence to all specification and submission instructions.
