PUBLIC NOTICE

The Jefferson County Department of Health gives notice that U.S. Steel Seamless Tubular Operations, LLC-Fairfield Works, Pipe Mill, an existing seamless steel pipe manufacturing company, located at 5700 Valley Road, Fairfield, Alabama 35064, has applied for a renewal of its existing Major Source Operating Permit (Permit No. 4-07-0371-06). The company also submitted permit applications for a new electric arc furnace to produce liquefied metal for its pipe making facility. The proposed electric arc furnace will be subject to subparts AAa of 40 CFR 60 (NSPS), 40 CFR 64 (CAM), and YYYYYY of 40 CFR 63 (NESHAP) regulations. There are also some smaller new sources which will be subject to federal NSPS and NESHAP regulations. Any other proposed new sources at this facility will be subject to the requirements of the Jefferson County Board of Health Air Pollution Control Rules and Regulations.

Copies of the draft permit may be inspected at the office of Environmental Health Services (Air & Radiation Protection Division), Jefferson County Department of Health, 1400 Sixth Avenue South, Birmingham, Alabama, from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday (holidays excluded). Within 30 days following the publication date of this notice, any interested person may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must indicate the reasons why a hearing is requested. If the Department determines that a petition constitutes cause or that there is significant public interest in the permit, the Health Officer may schedule a hearing.

The Jefferson County Department of Health is limited only to the air pollution aspect of the facility. Any comments relative to zoning or economic and social impact are within the purview of local zoning and planning authorities and should be directed to them.


After consideration of all written comments and a review of the public hearing record, the Department will make a final determination regarding permit issuance.
